At the end of 2015, there were about 600 PKH Hospitality and Industrial Skills 'graduates' working in Phnom Penh, Siem Reap, Sihanouk Ville, Bokor Mountains and Overseas (Abu Dhabi, Dubai, Seychelles, Korea, Cruise Liner based in Italy). The majority of them work in Phnom Penh, mainly in the hotels and food & beverage industry, and a few construction and engineering firms.

Today, you can find PKH 'graduates' working in the Himawari Hotel, Cambodiana Hotel, NagaWorld Hotel, Sunway Hotel, Raffles Hotel Le Royal, InterContinental Hotel, Holiday Villa, Sofitel PP Hotel, Dara Airport Hotel, Almond Hotel, Franjipani Boutique Hotel, Phnom Penh Hotel, Bellevue Hotel, Secret Recipe Café, FCC Café, Sokha Club, Hagar Catering Restaurant, Khmer Thai Restaurant, Lotus Engineering.

With jobs, all these young people are able to support themselves and also provide for their families in the provinces. They have had a chance to break out of the poverty cycle.
